

## WENDY DAVEE AWARD FOR SERVICE Service Award Criteria

The purpose of the Wendy Davee Award for Service is to recognize the distinguished achievements of alumni/ae or current student for their service to community building.

This Service Award (a crystal prism and a monetary gift) will be given to those who have had an extraordinary and positive impact on the community, including achievements within the Institute at large, local neighborhoods, and/or Pacifica's presence in the world. The monetary gift is intended as a donation to the honoree's service project(s). Successful nominations should demonstrate a significant and positive contribution to the Institute in one or more of the following ways:

- Building community
- Enhancing wellness
- Promoting diversity
- Demonstrating civic responsibility
- Actively volunteering
- Creating innovative and new projects or activities
- Innovating and enhancing existing Pacifica programs or services
- Exhibiting outstanding leadership with an organization or project

The following are eligibility requirements that must be met by each nominee.

- Nominees must be an alumni or undergraduate.
- Nominations should be based on achievements that date from August of the previous year; for the 2021 awards, nominations should be achievements between August 2019 and August 2020.
- Typically, work done as part of a compensated role is not considered, however extra-ordinary achievement by an alum or student who goes above and beyond the normal expectations may be considered. Please indicate in your nomination if this is the case.
- Current Pacifica Graduate Institute faculty and alums are eligible to nominate a candidate for the Wendy Davee Award for Service; self-nominations will not be accepted.
